A Post-doctoral Position is available in the group of Dr Helen Weavers to start from Summer/Autumn 2024. This is an exciting opportunity to explore **immune cell biology and tissue repair, and their dysregulation with age and disease.**

The lab takes a multi-disciplinary approach, integrating state-of-the-art microscopy, laser ablation, cell biology, 'omics, biophysics, computational methods and human genetic epidemiology. We use *Drosophila* for unparalleled opportunities to probe the subcellular dynamics of the immune response and tissue repair live *in vivo*.
